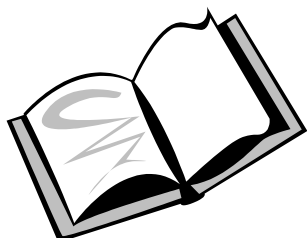
Magazines for the Library!

School is released at 2:50 p.m. Unless a student is involved in an after-school activity, students are expected to be picked up from the front door by 3:15 p.m.
